Audit Committee

The audit committee shall consist of one (1) executive committee director and one (1) Chapter member in good standing. An annual audit shall be performed by the audit committee on the Chapter funds prior to the annual meeting.

Communications Committee

The communications committee shall consist of at least two (2) executive committee members and shall oversee the website, newsletter and any publications relating to the Chapter to further education and public relations. Chapter members are encouraged to join the communications committee to assist with the publication of the newsletter and provide feedback on Chapter activities.

Education Committee

The education committee shall consist of at least two (2) executive committee members and shall include an education coordinator. The coordinator shall be appointed by the executive committee at the first executive committee meeting of each year and shall be responsible for all educational activities of the Chapter. Chapter members are encouraged to join the education committee to assist with the planning of educational events and the annual meeting. Feedback and input from Chapter members are essential to ensure that the Board meets the needs of the membership.

Executive Committee

The executive committee consists of the Board of Directors and Executive Officers. As openings occur, Chapter members are encouraged to express their interest in joining the Board and their desired position.

History (ad hoc)

The history committee routinely brings historic items of interest to the Board meetings, Chapter meetings, and may also contribute historic information to the newsletter.

Legislative Committee

The legislative committee shall stay informed of all proposed and approved legislation within the jurisdictional area of the Chapter.

Membership Committee

Membership is the responsibility of the secretary. Chapter members interested in assisting the secretary with maintaining a current roster of members, and inviting new members, are encouraged to join the membership committee.

Nominating Committee

The president by and with the consent of the executive committee, shall appoint a nominating committee of no less than three (3) Chapter members. It shall be the duty of the nominating committee to nominate at least one (1) Chapter member for each elective office existing in the Chapter and report its selection to the executive committee no later than October 1st.
